The newly formed Agricultural Commodity Commission for Equine held this special day to recognize all Georgia youth who had participated in a national equine show or event in 2008. These youth from all disciplines and breeds were invited to the State Capitol building of Georgia to be honored by The State of Georgia and the Department of Agriculture. In an overwhelming response, 150 young people showed up to receive this award honoring their participation in Equine activities.

The Equine Commodities Commission was set up to promote the equine

industry in Georgia -- which is the sixth largest commodity in Georgia. The Equine industry is now being recognized for the beneficial affect it has on the overall economy of the state of Georgia.

The Tennessee Walking Horse breed was proudly represented by Kinsley Beasley on Threat of Gen's Memory, Laney Bledsoe on Gen's D-Day, Haley Lane on I'm Uncle Kracker, Kyle Little on General Splash, Maisie McSwain on American General and Sundance Lady, Josh Poole on I'm John Bull, and Taylor Wheless on Rumble at the Ritz.

These youthful equine enthusiasts all showed at the Tennessee Walking Horse National Celebration in 2008, with some winning World Championships and World Grand Championships.

#### GWHLA MEETING MINUTES FEBRUARY 7, 2009 NEWNAN, GEORGIA

**Attendance:** Wanda Goodson, Oline Price, Melissa Underwood, Kathy Zeis, Joy Geske, Linda Jett, Rhonda Major, and Gloria Warr

President Wanda Goodson called the meeting to order, and introduced Linda Jett, as a new member. The minutes of the November 2008 meeting were approved after a motion was made by Kathy Zeis and seconded by Melissa Underwood. Linda Walden had to resign as Secretary, due to Mr. Thurman's health. Rhonda Major agreed to accept this responsibility with the assistance of Gloria Warr.

Treasurer Joy Geske did not provide a copy of the treasurer's report, but stated there was approximately \$700 in the account. The invoices for sponsorships for the 2008 show had not been mailed, but Joy and Kathy will have them mailed out by next week. The report will be updated after receiving checks from these invoices.

**GWHLA dues:** Would request they be mailed to Treas. Joy Geske no later than 3-31-09 or bring to first horse show, which would qualify member to show in the Auxiliary class. Dues are still \$20.

**Old Business:** Revisit the mission of GWHLA, goals and directions:

All were in agreement that the mission of the GWHLA is to promote good Horse Shows in Georgia, and to continue with this show if economically feasible.

**New Business:****Versatility Show:**

It was voted and approved to hold this show the morning of the same day as the GWHLA show. Kathy and Joy volunteered to set up for this show.

**Rider Cup Class:**

If it is agreed upon by WHTA, to have the smaller shows have a pay out of only \$200 per class, the rider cup will still be included in the GWHLA show. If the WHTA does not agree, then we will not have rider cup classes due to the cost. This was approved.

**GWHLA class only:**

It was discussed to have a class for GWHLA members only at the Southern Championship, rather than including any walking horse ladies auxiliaries' members. Kathy Zeis will discuss this at her next GWHEA meeting.

**GWHLA 2009 Show:****A. Sponsorships/Advertising:**

- \$325 (Deluxe) Company name/Barn with logo on back of T-Shirts - 2 free shirts included
  - \$200 for class sponsor to include an ad in the program
  - \$50 for half page ad
  - \$75 for whole page ad

**B. Show Site:** President Goodson provided numerous names and fees of different show sites. After much discussion, it was approved to have the show in Franklin, Georgia, on September 26, 2009 for a cost of \$400. The show ground officials agreed to make necessary improvements of the track by removing excess sand, watering and packing the show ring, providing better sound equipment, and making the ring oval. Linda Jett will provide amplifiers for outside the ring if necessary. It was tabled looking into an April Show for next year.

**C. Judges:** Dee Dee Sales, Jeff Hatcher and Kathy Zeis were suggested. After discussion, it was approved that Kathy Zeis would judge the show per gratis, since WHOA would be paying her expenses to judge the Versatility Show that morning. She so graciously offered her services to the association.

After crossing highway 27, Whitesburg, go about two miles and you will see a sign on the right side of the road with an arrow pointing to the left to Macintosh Reserve. ### **The Schedule**

Each time you go through you take your best five cards and make the best poker hand you can, at the end of the event the best poker hand will take half of the pot. The pot will be determined by how many participants there are in the Poker Obstacle Course. The seven obstacles will be: 1. Backing through an L made of hay bales, 2. Gate obstacle-once you start opening the gate your hand must remain on the gate until you go through the gate and close it, 3. Mail box-open the box take out the envelope, close box, open again put envelope in and raise the flag, 4. Take jacket off pole, put on the jacket and ride to next post, take jacket off and hang it up, 5. Ground tying your horse while you walk around it, 6. Caveletties-ride over at least four poles on the ground without tapping or hesitating, 7. Water glass over wooden platform must finish with at least half the water you started with.

## MINUTES FROM JANUARY 2009 GWHEA BOARD MEETING



**MEETING DATE:** Jan. 13, 2008

**LOCATION:** The Westin Hotel, Atlanta, GA

**TIME:** 7:30 pm EST

**ATTENDANCE:** All officers and board of directors were present except Kathy Hollin, Lindy Rogers, and Debra Hans. Visitors included: Wanda Goodson,

Stephanie White, Danny Rylee and Bobby Mixon.

Mr. Frank Shelton, President, called the meeting to order. He handed out a packet of information that would serve as our agenda for the night. He further stated that he had ideas on the direction he would like to see the Association go...and would further expound on those ideas during the meeting. He had mailed the handouts earlier in the week so the directors would have an opportunity to review the material prior to the meeting.

The November 11, 2008 minutes were reviewed and approved (motion made by Bill Cantrell and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kathy Zeis.)

The GWHEA Financial Report for period 12/13/08-1/13/09 was reviewed. Dr. Jones explained in details the line items of the report. The Park Avenue Bank's balance was \$16,651.52. The United (savings) Account's balance was \$37,346.10. The Southern Championship Horse Show profit was listed as \$6,444.00. It was noted that we had one outstanding sponsorship due in the amount of \$75. In addition, there was one returned check from a trainer. After discussion, if the trainer does not make the check good (including additional bank fees) by January 21, 2009, GWHEA Board approved to have his name submitted to the National Horse Show Commission for collection... motion made by Kathy Zeis and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joy Geske. The Treasurer's report was approved...motion made by Howard Woodman and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kathy Zeis.

President Shelton reviewed his packet of information. He stated that it is important to have goals for our association. He listed the following for us to consider:

- Increase membership by 50 (276-326)
- Increase Banquet attendance by 100 (50-150)
- Create one new GWHEA sponsored show in 2009

- Add 15 additional entries to each Saturday Night Show
- Have a Point System free of any controversy
- Find a meeting place conducive to our business
- Meet our objectives on budgeting and spending
- Be alert and responsive to others
- Have a successful SCCHS
- End the year with a unified and happy membership.

The board approved all the 2009 goals submitted.

**By-Laws...**President Shelton sighted Item E of the High-Point Award section for review by the by-law committee. In addition, the committee is asked to review Item G specifically looking at "a minimum of three classes". As noted, changes can only be made at the end of the year at the general membership meeting. President Shelton will ask David Mullis to review these items for action.

**Southern Championship Charity Horse Show.** President Shelton stated that GWHEA needs this show. The board voted to move forward with the SCCHS. Further information about date and location will be given at the next meeting.

**The Ambler:** Susan Paul has agreed to produce The Ambler in 2009. She is superb at this and her acceptance fills a big void. Ms. Paul expressed a concern and requested that we send paper copies to all members. The board approved this request and effective immediately The Ambler will be mailed to all current and past members until May, 2009...then only active current members will received this publication. It is important to include a membership application in each issue.

**Website/High-Point Tabulation:** Scott Green will continue to maintain the website again this year. He has done an excellent job for several years and we can expect good results this year. In addition, Scott will hopefully tabulate the TIP program along with the Hi-Pt program. Joy Geske will work with Scott and get him the information needed to keep the website current after each show.

**Membership:** In 2008, the GWHEA had a total membership of 276...24% were lifetime members. The TWHBEA has 449 members residing in Ga. and only 79 belong to the GWHEA. The Membership Committee has a huge task to recruit new members. Many suggestions were presented and will be further discussed once this committee has been assigned.

**Auditing:** President Shelton stated that the GWHEA was originally incorporated under another name....The Tennessee Walking Horse Exhibitor's Association of Georgia, Incorporated. Dee Cantrell contacted the Secretary of State and secured the necessary papers to correct the name change. The completed papers will be mailed with a \$20 check. The entity control number cannot be changed...only the name. In addition, a copy of the original incorporation papers was retrieved for our records.

**GWHEA Monies:** President Shelton asked that the board approve for \$35,000.00 be placed in a one year CD. Mr. Guy Ben Findley will secure the Certificate of Deposit and be responsible for its safe keeping. The authorized signatures on file for this CD will be Dr. Linda Jones, Treasurer and Guy Ben Findley. The board approved this action.

**2009 GWHEA High-Point Program...**this program will continue to function as in the past...with the owner, rider, and trainer...being GWHEA members to receive points. The trainer listed on the NHSC entry form must be a member for points to count. The same category of classes will be used as last year.

**Trainers Incentive Program...**Much of the success of a horse show is measured by the number of entries. Incentives are a good investment. A TIP program was approved by the board pending further detailing of specific classes. This will be reviewed in detail at our Feb. meeting for final approval.

### **Other Business:**

Board replacement for Kathy Zeis (Joey Tidwell's position). Bill Cantrell nominated Wanda Goodson and was seconded by Kathy Zeis. Board approved. Ms. Goodson will serve in this capacity until 2010.

Conyers Park location for horse show (July 18). This was tabled until the next meeting.

Meeting dates and location...President Shelton stated that he had looked at a few other locations for our meeting site. After discussion, Dee Cantrell was asked to call the Westin Hotel to see if the meetings could be held in the Chandler Room for the year. This will be further discussed at our Feb. meeting.

Review and assignment of Committee Chairs. This was tabled until the next meeting. President Shelton asked for the board members to

consider which committee they would like to serve on.

GWHLA President, Wanda Goodson, asked if the GWHLA (Auxiliary) could be a part of the GWHEA website. Board approved and Ms. Goodson will contact Scott Green for implementation.

Board approved a \$500 class sponsorship for the Walking Horse Trainers Show that will be held in Shelbyville, Tn March 18, 19, 20, 21, 2009.

Kathy Zeis reported that there would be a trail ride scheduled for March 28, 2009. More information will be forthcoming.

Kathy Zeis reported that Jerry Cole had asked her to share with the board several items: the Georgia Equine Commodities Commission will recognize all Georgia youth who have shown in any championship show. A handout was given to all those present. It was also shared that if you use the Perry Trade and Tourism logo on your class sheet, they will donate \$1500 in postage. This will be looked into for future usage.

Kathy Zeis will give a full update on all the confirmed shows for Georgia at our next meeting.
